SUBJECT: MAILBOX REPLACEMENT

Citizens can choose one of the following options for mailbox replacement damaged by our operation:

1. The Road Commission will exchange a mailbox and/or post that has been damaged by our operation with a regular type 1, 3, or 5, depending on the size of the original mailbox. The post will be replaced with a 4" x 4" x 6' treated wood post or a steel post, whichever type was damaged. It will be the property owners responsibility to bring in the damaged mailbox and/or post for replacement. These items will be left with the Road Commission. The Road Commission will not install these posts and/or mailboxes.
2. The Road Commission will pay the citizen \$15.00 in lieu of the new mailbox and/or post, with the checks being processed with the normal billing periods. It will be the property owners responsibility to bring in the damaged mailbox and/or post for payment. These items will be left with the Road Commission. The Road Commission will not install these posts and/or mailboxes.
