SUBJECT: ACCEPTING UNCERTIFIED STREETS INTO THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM

Uncertified streets are those streets that have been platted and dedicated to the public but were either never built or the Road Commission has not yet accepted jurisdiction over them. They can also include section line type roads that have been in disuse for many years. Accepting jurisdiction over these roads and certifying them without requiring that certain conditions be met could result in financial, public relations and liability problems.

All streets and roads shall comply with this Commission's published Standards and Specifications for Plat Development and Street Construction prior to their acceptance into the county road system, unless modified by the Road Commission.
